CEP Goals- Building Block 1

- Students have an opportunity to get money from the Kids Rise fund. We need to get more families to log in to Kids Rise to access their account.
- We are looking to create a workshop for parents of students in grades 4, 6, and 8 to explain that there is money sitting in their account and they lose access.
- Goal: Increase parent account activation from 46% to at least 51% by year-end so families can use the funds for college or CTE programs.

Student Council Election – PTA Meeting

- Honor the newly elected student council board at the upcoming PTA meeting on December 11
- PTA to get a pin or sash for the elected kids, which will be good for them to wear and greet politicians when they visit to the school
- List of winners to be provided to the PTA

Capital Project Proposal

- Mr. Wegiel is the teacher lead for the SPOCK program, which provides Chrome books (laptops) for students as long as they are part of the DOE
- Councilwoman Julie Won is conducting a participatory budget in which people in her district vote for ideas and the money is allocated to those ideas

- Proposal to upgrade technology, like laptops and Wi-Fi, for the school and there were a lot of responses
 - The aim is to equip each 6th and 7th grade classroom with dedicated laptops to reduce sharing, minimize wear, and extend device lifespan (around three years).
 - Expected funding request: **\$50–75K** for new laptops.
